- Talk to the Quartermaster



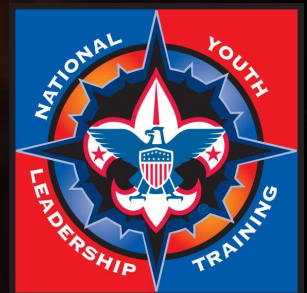
