

Letter about Orientation

Your National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) will start at Rancho Los Mochos on June 11. In preparation, please read this message carefully.

- 1) The mandatory Orientation meeting is Thursday, May 11 from 7:00 PM to 8:30 PM at Centerville Presbyterian Church, 4360 Central Ave, Fremont, CA 94536.
- Check-in starts at 6:15 PM. The staff will quickly interview each participant, review registration information and collect medical forms.
- ALL Participants are required to attend and to be in uniform. Parents should attend. Scout Leaders are welcome to attend.
- Many details will be discussed including equipment, arrival and departure times, course expectations, and much more.
- 2) **Medicals** Please bring a copy of BSA Annual Health and Medical Record (AHMR) parts A, B, & C and a photocopy of both sides of your health insurance card to turn in. Medical forms must be signed by a medical professional and dated after June 1, 2022 (yes, June of last year). You will save yourself and others a lot of time by turning in the medical forms at Orientation. Otherwise you must bring it to camp. We <u>cannot</u> accept emailed copies of medical forms. *Alternatively, you may mail them to the address given above.*
- 3) **Participant Photos** Please submit a head and shoulder picture (in .jpg format) wearing scout shirt and neckerchief via Photo Link. Examples of good pictures are shown on the form. Do note that this Google form requires that you be signed-in to Google before filling out the form and submitting the picture. Alternatively, you may submit pictures to nylt@ggacbsa.org. Please submit pictures by May 9 to save time at Orientation.
- 4) **Food restrictions** At orientation, each scout will be given a sheet that lists their basic contact information and food restrictions entered when they registered. This sheet needs to be carefully reviewed for accuracy, particularly the food restrictions. The reason is simple. We need time to prepare food that meets each scout's dietary needs, and attempting to accommodate them at camp, without knowing in advance, is extremely difficult or impossible.
- 5) **NYLT paraphernalia and extra T-shirts** We provide two T-shirts which the scouts will wear throughout the week. If you would like to order an additional T-shirt or other items, please refer to the attached <u>order form</u>.

After Orientation, you will receive periodic e-mails with additional information and important forms discussed during Orientation. These e-mails will also indicate what information is missing and a reminder of what forms you will need to bring with you on June 11 to get into Rancho Los Mochos.
